# 8. Update on Event Fund Raising permissions and plan 2021/2022

Beth Brown: Guidance is for caution but nothing to suggest that we cannot organise fundraising events at the school, other schools are planning for events that involve parents coming onto site.

Christmas Fayre - dates tbc and to avoid clash village church Xmas Fayre, Claire Scott to talk through template of Christmas event with Imelda Bamford-Carter.

Breaking the rules day – Beth Brown suggestion, Mufti day but with a twist, children can break the rules for the day, they pay 50p for every rule they break, so hair dye, jewellery,

sweets in lunch etc. Can raise more money than traditional Mufti day. Beth Brown to take a look at school calendar to pick date.

# 9. Fund Raising Requests

Beth Brown: Inspiring reading across the school, keen to get the library back up and running. Need an inspiring reading area in each classroom. Have asked staff what they would need to create a cosy area for reading in the classroom. To spend up to £1050 on funds to create reading areas in classrooms, proposed by Lisa James, seconded by Louise Mew, carried without objections.

Kelly Cheek asked about raised area in front of the Hedgehogs classroom. Beth Brown says it is unsafe. Karen Barber said other school has had financial input from EWR. KB to send BB email contact. Jayne Sinclair: builders at site across road from school have also been very helpful, another possible avenue for help.

### 10. AOB

Karen Barber – raised issue of Year 6 PGL coach trip costs – each year we have donated £1500 to cover cost of the coach travel. General consensus among attendees to continue approving this annual donation.

Adam Roberts – 20 to 25 brand new computers – my business no longer needs. Could the school use them? Or could we sell them and raise funds for the school? Beth Brown to follow up with Adam Roberts.
