

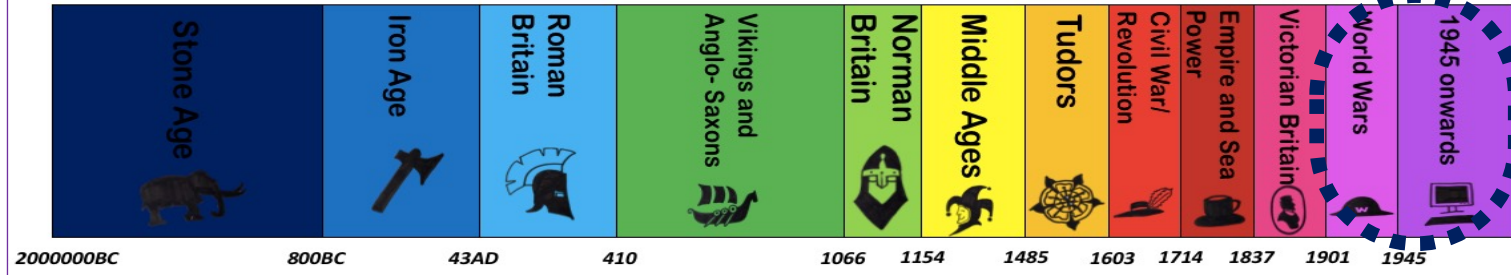

The BFG stands for the big friendly giant.



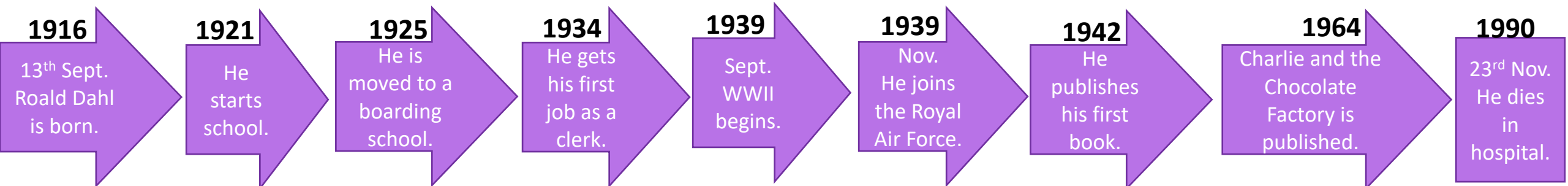
Willy Wonka
