Could you have a go at creating your own comic? You may want to link this to our focus story 'Toys in Space' by Mini Grey.</p>	<p><u>Task 3 - Dream School</u></p> <p>In History we will be looking at how schools have changed over time. I would like you to think about school, what do you like? What do you dislike? How would you change school if you could? Have a go at creating your own dream school. You may like to draw your school and annotate your ideas or even get creative and make your school.</p>	<p><u>Task 5- PSHE</u></p> <p>This term our PSHE topic is Dreams and Goals. As a new year begins we can set our aspirations for the future year ahead. What will 2025 bring for you? Do you have any dreams or goals? Set yourself a challenge to achieve one goal each week (6 in total for the term). Maybe your goal might link to one of our school values? How might you overcome any challenges you face along the way? You can share these goals in any way you choose, the more creative the better!</p>

You could even do more.</p>	<p><u>Task 2 – Amazing animals</u></p> <p>In Science we will be comparing animals. Can you create a fact file about your favourite animal that we can compare. You may even choose two different animals to compare at home!</p>	<p><u>Task 4 – Toys in Space</u></p> <p>Create a model of your own planet we could hang or display in the classroom. For the structure you could use a variety of materials e.g. paper plates, a paper lantern or even papier mache. Your planet will be complete once you attach some information to it: What is your planet called? What makes your planet special?</p>	<p><u>Task 6 - RE</u></p> <p>David and Goliath is a popular biblical tale from the book of Samuel. The story has an important message about bravery and taking responsibility. Find a version of the story that you like, read it and then retell the story. You might like to record yourself acting out the story, or you could create a cartoon storyboard. You could create puppets or retell the story using technology.</p>
