Can you create your own snakes and ladders board game to include adding or subtracting? If someone lands on a snake could you include a maths problem for them to answer? If they get it wrong they may slide down!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task 3 - Wacky Weather</u></p> <p>In Science this half term, we will be learning all about seasonal changes and the weather. Think of your favourite type of weather and create a piece of artwork to match it: it could be a sunshine collage, a watercolour rainy day or a cotton wool cloud mobile</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task 5- PSHE -Celebrating difference</u></p> <p>Diversity means understanding that each individual is unique, and recognising our individual differences. These differences might be our culture, religion, how we look, our hobbies, etc. Can you design a poster or presentation about diversity. This could be celebrating your own differences or promoting acceptance of diversity and why it is important for us all. What can we learn from others who are different from us?</p>

Can you create your own piece of Art including line and shape. Get creative!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task 4 – Wonderful World</u></p> <p>In Geography we will be focusing on what it is like in where we live. Have a think about the area you live in. Can you create a fact file about the area to share with others? Think about the different features you have around the place you live. What makes the place you live different from other places?</p>	<p><u>Task 6 – Create a visual representation of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) that shows they are three persons but one God.</u>Task Options: Children can choose one of the following ways to express their understanding: Poster / PPT / 3D Model</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Poster: Design a colorful poster that includes symbols or pictures representing the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. For example: A father figure or hand for the Father, A cross or Jesus for the Son, A dove or flame for the Holy Spirit PPT: Create a simple PowerPoint with 3 slides: Slide 1: Who is the Father? (Picture + sentence) Slide 2: Who is the Son? (Picture + sentence) Slide 3: Who is the Holy Spirit? (Picture + sentence) 3D Model: Build a small model using household items or craft supplies to represent the Trinity. For example: Three connected circles or figures, A triad of symbols (like a dove, cross, and hand) in one display
