<p><u>Home Reading</u> <i>Read 4x per week at home. Record your reading in your reading diary and ask an adult to sign your book too.</i></p> 	<p><u>Task 1 - English</u> In English we will be looking at the text 'Survivors'. The following is a quote taken from one of the first few paragraphs: <i>"With a shock the teenager realised she was somehow outside the aeroplane."</i> Can you take this sentence and use it to inspire your own piece of creative writing? Remember to include all your key pieces of grammar (fronted adverbials, conjunctions, consistent tense etc) and present this correctly if completing this by hand.</p>	<p><u>Task 3 - Science</u> In Science this term we will be looking at all creatures great and small. As part of this we will be learning about invertebrates and vertebrates. Could you create your own creature that belongs to one of these groups and describe it's key features and characteristics. Could you then state which group your creature belongs to and how you know. You could draw and label your own creature before writing an explanation or you could create a 3D model of this instead</p>	<p><u>Task 5- PSHE</u> This term our PSHE topic is Dreams and Goals. As a new year begins we can set our aspirations for the future year ahead. What will 2025 bring for you? Do you have any dreams or goals? Set yourself a challenge to achieve one goal each week (6 in total for the term). Maybe your goal might link to one of our school values? How might you overcome any challenges you face along the way? You can share these goals in any way you choose, the more creative the better!</p>
<p><u>Practice your times tables on TT Rock Stars</u> Complete 25 sessions of TTRS each week. You could even do more.</p>	<p><u>Task 2 – Maths</u> Take two dice, each of them numbered from 1 to 6. When the dice are rolled they can be combined in two different ways to make a number less than 10 with one decimal place. For example, if I roll a 2 and a 3 I can combine them to make 2.3 or 3.2. Now round each of these numbers to the nearest whole number: 2.3 rounds to 2 and 3.2 rounds to 3. Repeat for other rolls of the dice. Do both of the numbers you make ever round to the same whole number?</p>	<p><u>Task 4 – Geography</u> Linking with our topic 'Would you like to live in the desert?' Can you research one desert and share your findings? You could present this as a piece of non-fiction writing, a powerpoint, a recorded video or a poster. Think carefully about the facts that you include and how to correctly layout your work.</p>	<p><u>Task 6 - RE</u> David and Goliath is a popular biblical tale from the book of Samuel. The story has an important message about bravery and taking responsibility. Find a version of the story that you like, read it and then retell the story. You might like to record yourself acting out the story, or you could create a cartoon story-board. You could create puppets or retell the story using technology.</p>
