World Book Day Thursday 1st March 2018

Thursday 1st March is **World Book Day**; your child will receive their book token this week. Thanks to National Book Tokens and lots of lovely book publishers and booksellers, World Book Day, in partnership with schools all over the country, will be distributing more than 15 million £1 World Book Day book tokens to children (that's almost one for every child/young person under 18 in the UK and Ireland).

Spend! When you get your book token, all you need to do is to take it to your local bookseller (there's lots of them out there – find your local participating bookshop here and swap it for one of the TEN (exclusive, new and completely free) World Book Day books! Or, if you'd prefer, you can use your book token to get £1 off any full price book instead! If you'd rather get an audio book, that's fine too! It's your choice, just as long as the book or audio book costs at least £2.99

Dress up! We would love the children to dress up as their favourite character on Thursday 1st March and if possible bring in a favourite book to read to a child in another class.

Get Caught Reading! Take a photo of your child reading in an unusual place and send it to us at school. We would love to see where you might be curled up with a book. Even the most reluctant readers love a good challenge! We hope to create a display of the best photographs in school. We would like all photographs to be sent in by Friday 2nd March. Please send copies of photographs as we may not be able to return them.
